

# Aquaclean

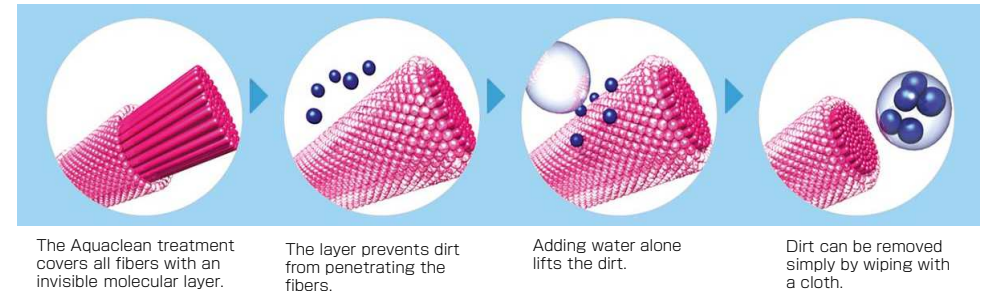
Aquaclean is a fabric treatment technology that allows you to remove stains with just water. This makes your interior fabric maintenance remarkably easy and quick.



## Point

### Easy maintenance with just water

Aquaclean is a fabric treatment technology that allows you to remove stains with just water. An invisible molecular layer prevents dirt from penetrating the fibers. Adding water lifts the dirt, and it can be wiped away.



## Point

### Various stains from daily life can be handled

Various stains from daily life, such as drinks like coffee and wine, foods like chocolate and cream, as well as sebum stains, mud, and even pet feces, can be removed.



### SAFEFRONT Treatment

The SAFEFRONT treatment effectively suppresses the activity of viruses and bacteria, which keeps the fabric clean. Furthermore, Aquaclean technology limits the penetration of viruses and bacteria.

## Point

### Safe and secure eco-friendly processing

Aquaclean has obtained OEKO-TEX STANDARD 100 certification, which proves environmental consideration and safety with no inclusion of substances harmful to the human body. It maintains world-class safety standards capable of complying with the stricter legal regulations of various foreign countries compared to Japan.



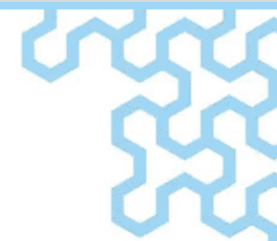
### OEKO-TEX STANDARD 100

OEKO-TEX STANDARD 100 is a label given only to textile products that have passed rigorous tests for harmful chemical substances. This label sets safety standards for textile products from a single thread to the final product. All products with the STANDARD 100 label are proven to have passed safety tests related to concerning harmful chemical substances.

# Aquaclean

Aquaclean upholstery makes daily cleaning easier because most indoor stains (wine, ink, sauce, grease, mud, chocolate, cream, etc.) can be relatively easily removed.

## Maintenance Method

### STEP 1

Remove any excess dirt spilled on the fabric.  
Please be careful not to spread the stain.

### STEP 2

Wet the stain directly or with a highly absorbent cloth dampened with water and wait a few seconds.

### STEP 3

Press a cloth against the stain and gently rub the fabric in a circular motion.  
If the stain is not completely removed, repeat this process.

#### For removing stubborn stains

Most stains can be removed with just water, but adding a small amount of neutral detergent can remove stubborn stains more easily.

**Note:** Oil-based stains, such as oil stains and permanent marker stains, which repel water, tend to be more difficult to remove than water-based stains.

## Maintenance Method (Disinfection/Deodorization)

### Using Alcohol (Manufacturer Recommended)

- Spray 70-degree alcohol onto the surface of the upholstery from about 30 cm away.  
Any disinfectant alcohol can be used.
  - Spread a dry cloth to absorb the excess alcohol.  
Note: Avoid scrubbing the surface too vigorously.
- Note:** The wood parts of CONDEHOUSE products are not compatible with alcohol disinfection.

### Using Soap

- Spray a 5% soap solution from 30 cm away.
  - Use a damp cloth to wipe away any soap residue.
- Note: Avoid scrubbing the surface too vigorously.

### Using Bleach

This method is not recommended as bleach can cause discoloration and leave a distinctive strong odor.

### Dry Cleaning or Hand Washing

The effectiveness of Aquaclean will diminish with repeated cleaning. Since water needs to reach the stain during cleaning, dry cleaning may have low effectiveness against stains.
